SUBMIT WRITTEN TESTIMONY so it may be filed as part of the bill's public record.

- 1. Put the testimony in either a Word document or PDF (not just the body of an email)
- 2. Include the bill numbers (for example HB5204, HB5429)
- 3. Include your name, and your town
- 4. Attach the document to an email
- 5. Put the bill number (see above) in the Subject Line of the email as well and whether you support or oppose

Email it to the committee holding the public hearing on a specific bill:

Planning & Development: pdtestimony@cga.ct.gov; Housing: hsgtestimony@cga.ct.gov or Transportation: Tratestimony@cga.ct.gov

Suggestion for testimony:

- Introduction: Begin with "Honorable Committee Members" refer to Committee List for details of all committee members if you want to email a specific committee – for info, visit cga.ct.gov
- Introduce yourself, your town and any relevant background that you may have.
- Indicate right away you oppose bill(s) \_\_\_\_\_, and why.
- Offer suggestions to improve it. Then explain your reasoning.
- Use recent comments provided on CT169Strong Facebook Page regarding the bills.

One size does not fit all and locally elected leaders and Planning and Zoning members are the most accountable to the residents of the municipality and can decide zoning issues in a manner that allows planned development without adverse impacts to the local infrastructure, the environment or historical preservation.
